13. SERMON (Preaching): Galatians 6:1-10 TEV

- 6:1 My brothers, if someone is caught in any kind of wrongdoing, those of you who are spiritual should set him right; but you must do it in a gentle way. And keep an eye on yourselves, so that you will not be tempted, too.
- 6:2 Help carry one another's burdens, and in this way you will obey the law of Christ.
- 6:3 If someone thinks he is something when he really is nothing, he is only deceiving himself.
- 6:4 Each one should judge his own conduct. If it is good, then he can be proud of what he himself has done, without having to compare it with what someone else has done.
- 6:5 For everyone has to carry his own load.
- 6:6 The man who is being taught the Christian message should share all the good things he has with his teacher.
- 6:7 Do not deceive yourselves; no one makes a fool of God. A person will reap exactly what he plants.
- 6:8 If he plants in the field of his natural desires, from it he will gather the harvest of death; if he plants in the field of the Spirit, from the Spirit he will gather the harvest of eternal life.

6:9 So let us not become tired of doing good; for if we do not give up, the time will come when we will reap the harvest.

6:10 So then, as often as we have the chance, we should do good to everyone, and especially to those who belong to our family in the faith.
